Their continued support, both financially and in not just allowing, but encouraging their support staff to belong and attend our training and conferences is part of the reason for our success.

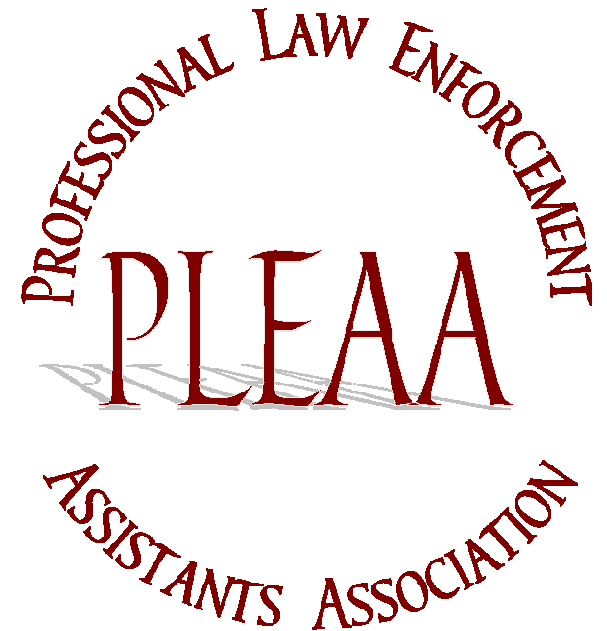
